Green Zones are rooted in environmental & economic justice, anti-displacement, equity, policy, and much more. We know that the residents of Phillips and Cedar-Riverside have been historically overburdened by environmental conditions such as traffic and stationary pollution sources, brownfield sites, blight, and substandard housing, and those areas were designated as Green Zones by the City of Minneapolis in 2017. In 2018, topics like healthy food access, health and energy in housing and air, water and soil quality have been explored by the Southside Green Zones Task Force; with an effort at creating policy, projects and programs that will impact people that live, work, play and/or worship in the zone. Green Zones is a multi-sector effort aimed at re-mediating this damage as well as improving outcomes for residents' health, wealth, employment, and education.
